1. Current CV or resume including educational background and work experience.
2. Unofficial Transcript/Academic Record
3. Two letters of recommendation, along with contact information for professors willing to provide such a letter. Recommendations are a key factor in the decision process, and should document:
  - (a) Under what circumstances the professor has known you
  - (b) Your accomplishments and potential for being a successful part of the internship program
  - (c) An overall evaluation of your past performance relative to other students at a comparable stage in their careers.
